2. The performance tasks evaluated will be selected from the following list:

- M18A1 Claymore Mine
- AT4
- Hand Salute
- Facing to the Right Flank
- The 30inch Step from the Halt and the Halt

- Left Shoulder Arms from Right Shoulder Arms and Right Shoulder Arms from Left Shoulder Arms
- Sling Arms from Order Arms, Order Arms from Sling Arms, and Adjust slings
- Inspection Arms from Order Arms
Order Arms from Inspection Arms
- 15- Inch Step Backward
- Marching to the Rear
- Count Off, Stack Arms, and Take Arms
- Forming, Aligning, and Dismissing the Squad
- Attack and Relax Position

3. Grading of the APFT will be to FM 21-20 standards. Grading of a performance task will be to the same standard as an IET soldier, to the written standard after the task.

4. When modules are selected, they will be graded the same as in Drill Sergeant School, with the exception of not being told to "Close out your method of instruction" or that "You are becoming ineffective." You will simply receive point deductions for missed pertinent points. The candidate will recite the module from steps one through three only once. When tasks are selected they will be graded off the performance measures out of the IET handbook TRADOC Pam 600-4.
